

Klughaus: Graffiti USA Scholarship

Program Guidelines

Klughaus Gallery, LLC has established a scholarship program to assist students who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school and major in business or fine arts.

Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability, or national origin.

Eligibility

Applicants to the Klughaus: Graffiti USA Scholarship Program must:

- Be high school seniors or graduates, or current postsecondary undergraduates
- Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year
- Plan to major in business or fine arts

Awards

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award of \$2,500. 1 award of \$2,500 will be granted. Awards are one time only. Past recipients may not reapply.

Awards are for undergraduate study only.

Required Documents

As part of your application, you must upload a complete transcript of grades. Grade reports are not accepted. Unofficial or online transcripts must display student name, school name, grades and credit hours for each course, and term in which each course was taken.

Your application is **not** complete unless all required documents are submitted electronically. We will follow up with you by email for any missing documents required.

Program Deadline

Your application must be submitted **by 3:00 pm Eastern Time on May 15, 2020.**

Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, statement of career and educational goals and portfolio if applicable. Klughaus will award one recipient from 10 finalists. Finalists may be required to provide further detailed information.

Notification

Applicants will be notified by the end of June. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

Payment of Scholarships

Klughaus Gallery, LLC will make payment in August directly to the college/university attending.

Obligations

Recipients have no obligation to Klughaus Gallery, LLC. They are, however, required to notify Klughaus of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information, and to send a complete official transcript when requested.

Revisions

Klughaus Gallery, LLC reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
